<u>Eligibility</u>

Criteria/Rules for awarding scholarships

- Is a victim/survivor of domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking
- Has been affected by domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking (i.e child who has witnessed domestic violence, ect.)
- Illinois Resident Applying for College or Trade School
- You must be currently enrolled or have been accepted into an accredited College, Trade School, or University.
- You must submit a completed application and essay based on one of the topics below.

<u>Awards</u>

Participants of the scholarship are awarded up to \$2,500 from the Doves Hope Foundation. Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the organization based on the criteria specified. Funds are paid directly to the recipient's educational institution and cannot be used for any other purpose.
